NVIDIA[®] ION[™] Creative Use Contest

NVIDIA Corporation invites you to show a creative way to use an NVIDIA ION-based PC (hereinafter "<u>Contest</u>"), and winners of this Contest will receive exciting NVIDIA prizes, subject to the following Official Rules.

OFFICIAL RULES

By entering this Contest, you agree to be bound by these Official Rules and to comply with all applicable laws and regulations.

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER THIS CONTEST. THIS CONTEST IS VOID WHERE RESTRICTED OR PROHIBITED BY LAW. 1. <u>SPONSOR</u>

3. THE CHALLENGE

7. JUDGING

The winning entry for this Contest will be selected using the following process:

(a) Three finalists will be selected by a panel of judges consisting of the following individuals from NVIDIA: Mark Aevermann, Ashley McBroom, David Ragones, Eva Wasiewlewski, and Demy Huang (hereinafter collectively the "Judges" and individually "Judge"), using the following judging criteria and scoring system:

- <u>Initial impression</u> (0 50): The coolness impression that a Judge gets when reviewing the use. The stronger the emotional effect on a Judge, the higher the score will be.
- <u>Uniqueness</u> (0 50): How unique is the use? The more unique the effect is, the higher the score will be.

An entry will be given an "Initial Impression" score and a "Uniqueness" score from each Judge, with "0" being the lowest score" and "50" being the highest score. The three entries with the highest total score will be the finalists. The Judges shall have the sole authority and discretion to select the finalists, and all decisions of the Judges shall be FINAL. By entering this Contest, you agree to be bound by the decisions of the Judges.

(b) The entries of the three finalists will then be posted on the Contest Website **June 8th**, **2009** for final judging by the public based during a 1 week period. The finalist entry that receives the highest number of online votes during such period will be declared the winner of this Contest.
